Lack of breastfeeding has negative health consequences for all children and especially so for ill and premature babies. The particular benefits of breastmilk feeding to premature babies includes a reduction in the incidence of the potentially fatal bowel condition, necrotizing enterocolitis, and improved brain and eye development. Skilled support with breastfeeding in the area of neonatal care is especially important in helping to ensure breastfeeding gets off to a good start. This seminar will provide an opportunity for those involved in supporting breastfeeding in special circumstances to update their knowledge and to increase the effectiveness of the care they provide.
